ASEL ART AWARDS Artist of the Month Competition!



Summertime is the time to get painting for the fall, winter and spring meetings! SWA members are invited to bring a completed piece to our monthly meeting. The artwork is shown anonymously with each member in attendance voting once for their favorite. After winning $\mathbf{1}^{\text{st}}$ place, that artist retires from the competition for the remainder of the calendar year. Those who win $\mathbf{2}^{\text{nd}}$ place may continue to compete with other pieces of

work. Art work previously shown in a SWA juried exhibit is not allowed. The first place winner goes home with a \$25 Asel gift certificate and 2nd place earns one for \$15. In November all first place pieces during 2016 will return for selection of "Artist of the Year." Many thanks to Mary T House who chairs this fun event for us each month! Cost is \$250 for members and \$300 for non-members. A \$75 non-refundable deposit secures your place. Sign up and payment should be made on the SWA website. A supply list will be added to the website soon.

The materials list is as follows but do bring all the material you normally use for painting, especially brushes and paints.

Nos. 4, 8, 10, 12 round brushes (Silver Black Velvet)

2" and 2.5" hake brushes for washing technique (more than 2 is better)

140 pound Cold-pressed watercolor paper (half sheet, 22"x15") or 300 pound cold-pressed paper (Preference: Arches or Winsor & Newton)

A sturdy board; ply wood; gator board; bath board of size 24"x17" 1/8 inches that will fit the paper you are painting 1.5 inches or 2 inches masking tape

Palette

Water Bowl

Frisket (Masking Fluid)- I prefer yellow colored Winsor & Newton Cotton rag or paper towels (old 100% cotton towel or terry cloth) Mechanical pencil with .5 mm HB and an eraser Spray bottle

Cadmium Yellow Medium or Light

Hookers Green

Indigo

Permanent Alizarin Crimson

Permanent Rose

Prussian Blue

Scarlet Lake
