# Fanet Rogers ONLINE WORKSHOP Fabruary 8 - 10, 2021





#### START YOUR NEW YEAR WITH A SWA WORKSHOP!

Perhaps you were introduced to Janet Rogers during our October SWA zoom meeting with her. Janet was our juror for the 2020 Membership Exhibition, but the pandemic cut short our expectations as we had to delay a workshop.

She is offering us an online workshop Monday through Wednesday, February 8th thru 10th. Ours will be a small group, but a few places remain for participants.

Janet has been a working professional artist for over 32 years, and is a nationally recognized instructor, conducting workshops all over the United States and in Europe, and is a Signature member of the American Watercolor Society, Florida Watercolor Society as well as others, winning many awards for her paintings.

Fresh flowers in the studio will be the inspiration to begin this dynamic workshop – progressing to faces. Through a series of fun painting exercises, students will develop a more loose and natural approach – giving them an opportunity to be more spontaneous and expressive in their paintings.

With the portrait, she will show how to express translucent flesh tones, as well as features of the person. Painting children will also be covered. Janet will demonstrate her intuitive approach throughout the workshop and work individually with each student coupled with class instruction.

She will send photos and drawings which can be used by students for fun interpretations in a quick and spontaneous manner.

During the workshop we will be able to see each other and share our work during "Show and Tell." Her cameraman, Steve (husband) will make a recording available to all participants.

Her paintings and articles have appeared in *Artist's Magazine, Watercolor Magic Magazine, North Light Book, Southwest Art Magazine, Watercolor Artist Magazine, International Artist Magazine, The Art of Watercolour* and *Pratique des Arts.* 



Her paintings were included in *Splash: The Best of Watercolor 8, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17, 18* and *19* and published in *Strokes of Genius: The Best of Drawing of 3* and *4.* She is published in two watercolor instructional books: "Vibrant Flowers in Watercolor" and "Painting Vibrant Watercolor: Discover the Magic of Light, Color and Contrast" both with North Light Book Publications. In the book "Watercolor Secret" she contributed one chapter: "Create Drama with Bold Composition." Soon is responsible for the creation of seven DVDs and her paintings are in permanent collections of private, corporate and educational institutions both nationally and internationally. SWA was the first art organization in the DFW area to facilitate a virtual Painting of the Month contest during 2020.

We plan to continue this fun way to share our paintings and have a friendly competition.

Many thanks to **Asel Art Supply** who generously sponsors our monthly contest. Each month our members are invited to submit an image of their painting which then competes anonymously. Artwork that has appeared in a SWA exhibition or previous SWA Art of the Month is not allowed. (Please note the winners may redeem their certificate at any Asel Art Supply retailer or online.)
