






Maureen Lewis's painting California Captive won 2nd Place at the recent SWS Annual Membership exhibition in Dallas. Juror - Stan Miller














Darla also has her painting Packard 1925 on display at the Artscape City of Frisco Rail Station.













Local Watercolor Classes

Marilyn Ivy is leading a series of three beginning watercolor classes at the House of NeVille Gallery and Gatherings 2409 Neville St. in Fort Worth, 76107.

Carol Ivey is teaching Watercolor Painting from Observation: a process from drawing to painting. Knowledge of the basics of color mixing and watercolor paint handling are required. The last two classes develop one or more finished paintings from observed still life and/or photo sources.
