

As I was standing in line, along with a few hundred anonymous grocery shoppers, it struck me how much our little world has changed, and how grateful I am that I


Generally I paint, draw, sculpt and carve what interests me. However, commissions interest me!


live in the warm weather of Texas.

The prospectus will be released in the coming weeks. More information on his workshop will be released soon.















Yuji Uchiyama has been invited to serve as a Master in the 2026 International Watercolour Masters in Lilleshall, Shropshire, England.





CLOTHESLINE ART




